A Resolution to Approve the Expenditure of ARPA Funds to Purchase Updated Body and Squad Camera's

Whereas, Buffalo County received funds through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) to provide substantial infusion of resources to continue to decrease the spread of COVID-19 and bring the pandemic under control, and;

Whereas, Buffalo County has received \$2,527,282.00 directly from the federal government with guidelines on how the funds can be spent, and;

Whereas, the purchase of updated Squad and Body Cameras will provide updated technology and reliable file storage, will aid in capturing details of encounters with the public, will aid in investigating details of incidents that are time sensitive, will aid in transparency with the public and;

Whereas, the Finance Committee approves the purchase and installation of 13 updated squad and body cameras in an amount not to exceed \$170,000.00, and;

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the purchase of updated Squad and Body Cameras in an amount not to exceed \$170,000.00 with the funds coming from ARPA funding.






