Meeting called order at 12:02 p.m.

Verification of Open Meetings Law Compliance: Verified through Ms. Schmitt that proper notice of the meeting was given in compliance with Wisconsin Open Meetings Law at least 24 hours prior to this meeting.

Approve Agenda: Ms. Campbell Wood accepted the motion to approve the CJCC Agenda, seconded by Ms. Stewart. Motion carried.

Approve Minutes from Previous Meeting(s): Ms. Campbell Wood accepted the motion to approve the CJCC Minutes, seconded by Mr. Nelson. Motion carried.

Public Comment: None

Reports:

- a. *CJCC Financial Report* ~ Gina Rieck: See report below. Balance remains at \$31,639.66.
- b. *Community Work Service Program Report* ~ Gina Rieck: See report below. In 2026, there have been 8 new participants, 4 successful completions, and 8 pending cases, some of which were carried over from last year.
- c. *Buffalo County Jail Report* ~ Ms. Scholl: See report below. The jail population changes daily. There were a couple of prison intakes this week, and Buffalo County continues to house inmates in other counties. Ms. Campbell Wood inquired about current housing placements. Ms. Scholl stated that inmates are transitioning from the Trempealeau County Jail to the Pierce and Dunn County Jails.
- d. *Pepin County Jail Report* ~ Ms. Feuling: Absent. See report below.
- e. *Moving Forward Reentry Program Report* ~ Ms. Campbell Wood: In May 2026, six classes were offered with a total of 31 participants, including 29 participants from Buffalo and Trempealeau Counties and 2 participants from Pepin County. Four classes are being offered in June; however, no inmates have registered currently. Ms. Campbell Wood reported that she is working on developing a plan with the Pierce County Jail over the next couple of weeks to establish educational classes. She also stated that she already has a partnership in place with Dunn County Jail.

Mr. Roesler asked Ms. Campbell Wood if she would offer training to Buffalo, Pepin, and Dunn Counties on Motivational Interviewing and the Youth Assessment and Screening Instrument (YASI). Ms. Campbell Wood stated she would provide funding to hire an individual to conduct the training. She indicated that she still needs to discuss it with Mr. Roesler and Ms. Reggin who would be providing the training, with hopes of offering it this year.

Mr. Roesler and Ms. Reggin expressed interest in offering training opportunities to law enforcement and social workers in Pepin, Buffalo, and Dunn Counties. Ms. Schalinske stated there is no direct connection between YASI youth assessment training and law enforcement and would not encourage law enforcement participation in the training.

Ms. Campbell Wood stated that the recovery coach is part of the Reentry Program and expressed disappointment with how the program is progressing. She reported that \$8,700 was provided as a cash match contingent upon utilization of the recovery coach services within the Trempealeau County Jail; however, the recovery coach has been underutilized. Ms. Campbell Wood stated there is a new contract period from September 2026 through August 2027, but she will not be providing the \$9,100 cash match due to the lack of utilization of the recovery coach services and the need to remain accountable for funding.

Ms. Campbell Wood reported that she received \$33,000 from the Office of Financial Services to extend the Moving Forward Program through December 31, 2026. After that date, the funding will end. She requested input from committee members regarding potential options to continue funding the program. Judge Clark asked Ms. Campbell Wood to circulate ideas prior to the next meeting, including specific figures, and present the information to committee members at the July meeting.

- f. *Community Justice Services (CJS) Report* ~ Ms. Bautch: See report below. Active participant numbers are down due to many individuals successfully completing the program. The Intoxicated Driver Intervention Program (IDIP) has been utilized more frequently, resulting in increased participation numbers. The report now includes total participant numbers entering the program from 2027 to the current quarter.

Correspondence (for any emails, letters, voicemails received, etc.): None.

Future Agenda Items:

- 1. Ms. Mary Campbell Wood will present her ideas and specific figures regarding the sustainability of the Reentry Program.
- 2. Ms. Stewart will share some policy and procedure changes that have been implemented as part of the jail nursing program (Healthy Life Style Promotion, Harm Reduction Education with Supply, Chronic Disease Care Plans).
- 3. Ms. Berning will be requesting approval from committee members to apply for and accept 2027 TAD Grant Funding.

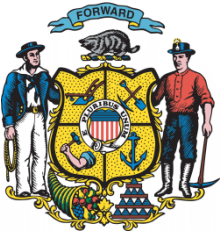
