Huber & Electronic Monitoring Information

The Court may give persons sentenced to the Buffalo County Jail Huber/Electronic Monitoring privileges. This privilege was established by statute so that persons confined to jail can maintain their employment, continue to support their families and meet other obligations. Huber and Electronic Monitoring must be approved by the Buffalo County Jail. Sentenced persons are not automatically eligible. *Huber may not be approved if there are current open cases, the crime is victim related, if there are prior resisting/obstruction charges etc.*

Persons interested participating in Huber or Electronic Monitoring must be in contact with the Buffalo County Jail **20 days prior** to the sentence date to complete appropriate paperwork and must be employed prior to sentencing.

Sentenced persons will be required to pass a drug and alcohol screening at their own expense (\$15) and required to pay a \$20.00 Booking Fee.

Electronic Monitoring requires a \$100 non-refundable equipment fee, Electronic Monitoring hook-up days are **Thursday afternoons (1pm-2pm)** at the Buffalo County Jail.

Sentenced persons will be **required to sit 10% (3 day minimum)** of their sentence in the Buffalo County Jail without Huber or Electronic Monitoring.

Daily Cost for Serving Huber/Work Release Sentence:

- If you were sentenced in Buffalo County - \$20.00
- If you were sentenced out of Another County - \$30.00
- If you are out on Electronic Monitoring - \$30.00
- If you are out for Child Care- \$5.00
