

ORDINANCE # 01-07-02

An ordinance relating to the adoption of a county non-metallic mining program

WHEREAS, Chapter 295 Wisconsin Statutes requires all counties in the State of Wisconsin to enact and administer non-metallic mining ordinances in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 135, and;

WHEREAS, this ordinance is being enacted separately from any ordinance previously adopted under s. 59.69 Wisconsin Statutes requiring public hearing, and;

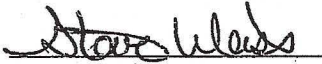
WHEREAS, Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 135 allows the county to levy fees collected from mine operators to fund the administration of this program, and;

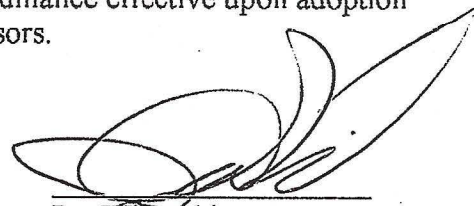
WHEREAS, Buffalo County realizes the advantages of local administration of this program while understanding that s. 295.18(4) Wisconsin Statutes states: "If the department (DNR) issues a written decision... that a county is not in compliance with this subchapter and the rules promulgated under this subchapter, the department shall administer the non-metallic mining reclamation program in that county...", and;

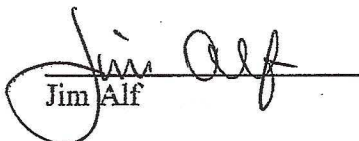
WHEREAS, the draft ordinance has received approval from the Department of Natural Resources.

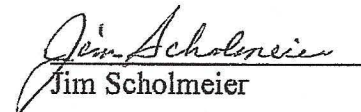

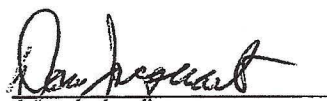
