

ORDINANCE # 03-02-02

An amendment to a code of ordinances titled the "Buffalo County Zoning Ordinance"

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo County hereby Ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2003 the Buffalo County Board prepared amendments to a code of ordinances titled the "Buffalo County Zoning Ordinance" in pamphlet form and placed the same on file in the office of the County Clerk, and;

WHEREAS, such amendments to said code of ordinances have been open to public inspection at the office of the County Clerk prior to its adoption on February 18, 2003 for a period of not less than two weeks, and;

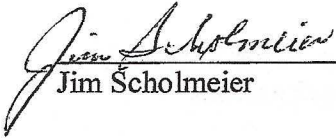
WHEREAS, notice of amendments to said code of ordinances was given by publication in the official county newspaper in accordance with s. 66.0103 Wis. Stats., and;

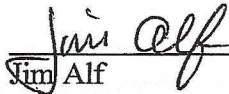
WHEREAS, the Buffalo County Zoning Committee held a public hearing on February 6, 2003 in accordance with s. 59.69 Wis. Stats. for the purpose of gathering testimony and ultimately developing a report and recommendation to the full board of supervisors, and;

WHEREAS, it is the report and recommendation to the full board of supervisors to adopt said amendment with any modifications as properly acted upon and approved by the committee following said hearing.

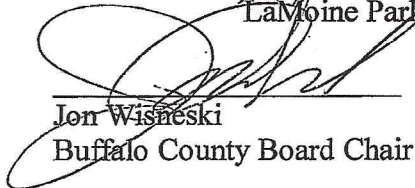

ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT: ATTACHMENT "B"
ORDINANCE # 03-02-02

Article IV. AGRICULTURE DISTRICT

Section 40
Permitted Uses

8. Tourist Rooming Houses as defined in Wis. Admin. Code HFS 195 provided that:
 - (a) Proper methods for treatment of domestic generated wastewater as prescribed in the Buffalo County Sanitary Ordinance and Wis. Admin. Code COMM 83 are maintained.
 - (b) No tourist rooming house shall be located within 1,000 feet of another tourist rooming house except upon granting of a conditional (special) use permit as prescribed in Article XXI.
 - (c) The structure is located a minimum of 500 feet from any livestock animal feedlot, 500' from any animal waste storage structure (unless a greater distance is required by other Wis. Admin. Code requirement) and 200 feet from any structure used for the permanent enclosure of livestock; other than that of the tourist rooming house owner.
 - (d) A zoning permit is applied for by and issued to the property owner where the structure is to be located indicating that the structure will be used as a tourist rooming house.
 - (e) It shall be the responsibility of the tourist rooming house owner to comply with State Department of Health administrative code requirements.
