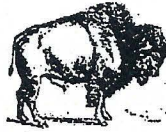

ORDINANCE # 04-10-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUFFALO COUNTY ZONING AND SANITARY ORDINANCE FEE SCHEDULES

To The Honorable Buffalo County Board of Supervisors:

Whereas, the Buffalo County Zoning Department is charged with administration of the county's Non-metallic Mining Program, and,

Whereas, revenue generated by the county's Non-metallic mining program will decrease by \$9,600 due to maximum allowable fee reductions mandated by Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 135, and,

Whereas, a large portion of this revenue loss can be recaptured by modest fee increases for sanitary and zoning permits, Wisconsin Fund applications and uniform address signs, and,

Whereas, these user fees will still remain commensurate with services provided and comparable to fees collected by counties within West Central Wisconsin.

Now, therefore, Buffalo County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

In-ground pressurized and non-pressurized, mounds, at-grades, holding tanks, aerobic and experimental treatment systems, system modifications: \$250.00 *amended to* \$275.00

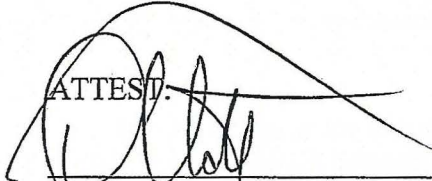

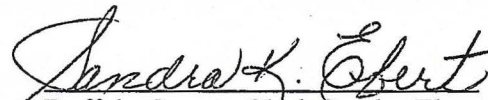
FUTURE STATUTORY AMENDMENTS, REVISIONS AND MODIFICATIONS. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of applicable Wis. Stats. are incorporated herein and made part of this Ordinance.

SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Board of Supervisors would have passed the other provision, sections, subsections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2005 and be in force on and after this date until amended and after passage and publication as provided by law.

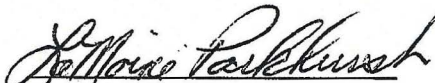
