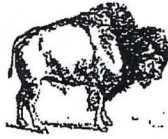

ORDINANCE # 06-01-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUFFALO COUNTY SANITARY CODE OF ORDINANCES

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo County hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, On December 20, 2005 the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors voted in favor to take under consideration proposed revisions to a code of ordinances entitled "The Buffalo County Sanitary Ordinance Article XIII" and placed the same on file in the Office of the County Clerk for a period of time greater than two weeks prior to January 17, 2006, and;

WHEREAS, the Buffalo County Zoning Committee held a public meeting on January 10, 2006 for the purpose of gathering testimony and developing a final draft of said revisions to recommend to the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors, and;

WHEREAS, notice of this meeting and the board's final consideration of adoption on January 17, 2006 was published in the "2005 Buffalo County Official County Newspaper" in accordance with s. 66.0103 Wisconsin Statutes, and;

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation to the board of supervisors to adopt said revisions as approved by the zoning committee during their January 10, 2006 public meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby adopt said revisions to the code of ordinances entitled "The Buffalo County Sanitary Ordinance Article XIII" which shall be kept permanently on file and open to public inspection in the Office of the County Clerk, and;

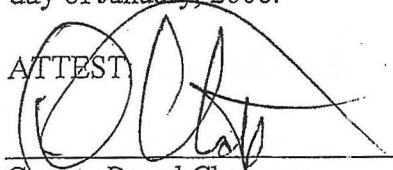
BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that these revisions to this code of ordinances shall take effect and be in force after passage and publication of the notice of adoption as required by law.

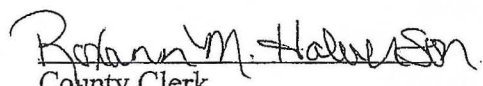
REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance heretofore enacted by the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Buffalo County Board would have passed the other provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

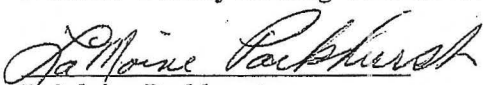
