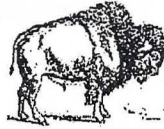

ORDINANCE # 14 - 01 - 01

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE BUFFALO COUNTY BEEKEEPING ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo County hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, On August 27, 2013 and November 1, 2013 the Buffalo County Land Resources (Zoning) Committee considered an ordinance to repealing the ordinance "Buffalo County Beekeeping Ordinance" and placed the same on file in the Office of the County Clerk for a period of time greater than two weeks prior to January 15, 2014, and;

WHEREAS, the Buffalo County Land Resources (Zoning) Committee held a public hearing on January 15, 2014 for the purpose of gathering testimony and developing a final draft to recommend to the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors, and;

WHEREAS, notice of this meeting and the County Board's final consideration of adoption was published in the "2014 Buffalo County Official County Newspaper" in accordance with s. 66.0103 Wisconsin Statutes, and;

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to adopt the ordinance as approved by the Land Resources (Zoning) Committee during their January 15, 2014 public meeting following the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby adopt the following ordinance entitled "The Buffalo County Ordinance to Repeal the Buffalo County Beekeeping Ordinance" which shall be kept permanently on file and open to public inspection in the Office of the County Clerk:

Buffalo County Ordinance to Repeal the Buffalo County Beekeeping Ordinance

I. Purpose

1. The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal the Buffalo County Beekeeping Ordinance in its entirety. The Ordinance was adopted by the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors on June 2, 1975, under the authority granted by Section 59.07(64) of the Wisconsin Statutes (1973).

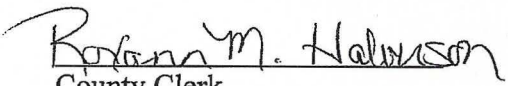
BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect after publication of the notice of adoption as required by law.

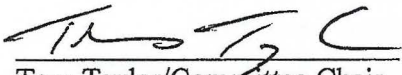

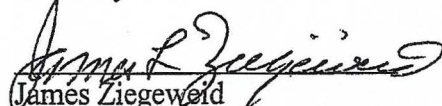

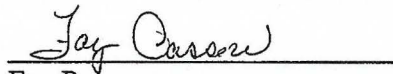
