

ORDINANCE # 96-04-01

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUFFALO COUNTY FLOODPLAIN ORDINANCE AS A CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR BUFFALO COUNTY.

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo County do hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1996 Buffalo County prepared a code of ordinances entitled "The Buffalo County Floodplain Zoning Ordinance" in pamphlet form and placed the same on file in the office of the County Clerk, and;

WHEREAS, such code of ordinances has been open to public inspection at the office of the County Clerk prior to its adoption on April 16, 1996 for a period of not less than two weeks, and;

WHEREAS, notice of such code of ordinances under WI Stats. 66.035 was given by publication in the official county newspaper according to the provisions of WI Stats. 66.035, and;

WHEREAS, the adoption of this ordinance is one requirement for Buffalo County to remain in good standing with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and to receive state and federal assistance if disaster declarations are made.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the "Buffalo County Floodplain Zoning Ordinance" is hereby adopted as a code of ordinances of Buffalo County and shall be kept permanently on file and open to public inspection in the office of the County Clerk.
