RESOLUTION # 26-08-03

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE REQUIREMENTS OF WISCONSIN STATUTE § 70.11(20) HAVE NOT BEEN SATISFIED

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo County has received information and documentation concerning property located at:

Parcel Number: 010-00158-0000

Property Address: S.3044 Baertsch Valley Road, Fountain City, WI – Town of Cross

Owner: Fountain City Rod and Gun Club Inc

and;

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute § 70.11(20) provides for property tax exemption when the statutory requirements set forth therein are satisfied;

and;

WHEREAS, The Buffalo County Board has reviewed the information provided by the property owner, applicable records, and other relevant documentation regarding the ownership, use, and operation of the property; and;

WHEREAS, The Buffalo County Board finds that the property is not owned, operated, and utilized in a manner consistent with the requirements established under Wis. Stat. § 70.11(20);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby determines that the property identified above does not satisfy the requirements of Wisconsin Statute § 70.11(20) because it appears that a limited portion of the property is used to preserve native wild plant or native wild animal life, Indian mounds or other works of ancient persons or geological or geographical formations of scientific interest. The property is not open to the public. The Town Board is also in opposition of the exemption.

The county board of the county where the property is located has determined that the property is not owned by, or held in trust for, a nonprofit organization and has determined that at least one of the requirements under pars. (a) to (c) has not been fulfilled.



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Buffalo County Clerk is authorized and directed to transmit this determination and any supporting documentation to the appropriate assessing and taxing authorities as may be required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
